## Please skip this document if your operating system is NOT Windows 10!

For Windows 10 user, in order to install USB Driver properly, the following steps must be followed before the installation of SiteView software:

## 1. Restart PC for Advanced Options

A. Click Start button (the lower-right corner of the screen) and select Settings.



B. Select Update and Security, then select Recovery. Under Advanced Startup choose: Restart Now.

## 2. Change Advanced Options

C. Now Windows 10 will restart in the advanced menu options, click on Troubleshoot.



D. Click the **Startup Settings** option from the menu.

E. The Startup Settings will allow you to change various Windows configuration options. Click **Restart**.

F. Now Windows 10 will reboot. But instead of going to the Desktop it will start in the Startup Settings page. Choose option: **7**) **Disable driver signature enforcement** by pressing F7 or the number 7. Then the windows will boot to the mode allowing the USB Driver to be installed properly.



Windows 10 is now ready for SiteView installation.
